Fishing

Ladies and Juniors Day

Near perfect weather greeted the boats that fished last Saturday's casual event, with mahi mahi being the main species and two anglers hopefully to be awarded State and Australian records.

The early bird team on Rascal skippered by Ben Punch were towing lures past the Fibrelite Boats FAD at 6:30 and were pounced upon by mahi mahis, including one of 6.93kg caught by new member Morgane Chebahi on 3kg. This fish has been entered for a State record in the line class.

Unbeknown to skipper Ben, a crew member who shall remain nameless, smuggled aboard a banana. This didn't appear to have the expected effect as the boat made a clean sweep of champion boat and angler categories.

Only a couple of boats ventured as wide as the Trench, the other being Shane Anderson's Vanquish with angler Lochlan Turrell on board who caught a 4.13kg mahi mahi on 3kg line to claim a new small fry record.

Salmon were conspicuous by their absence but smaller samsonfish were active around the the D9 in Cockburn Sound

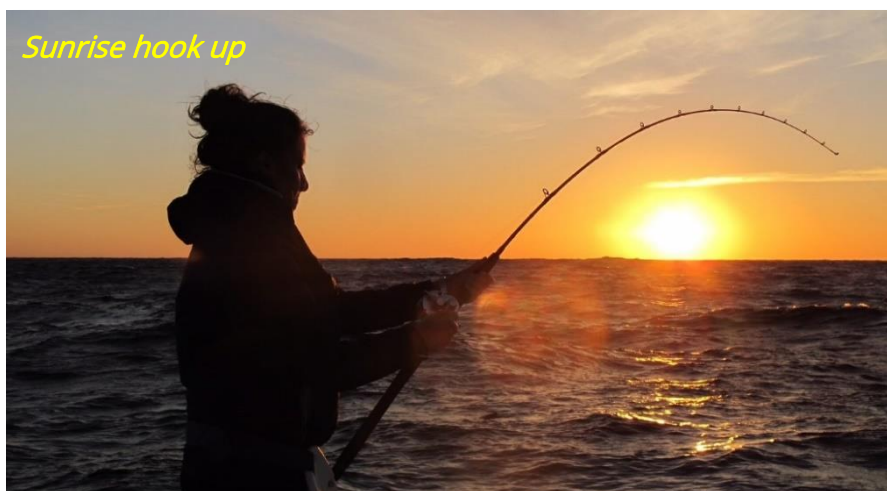

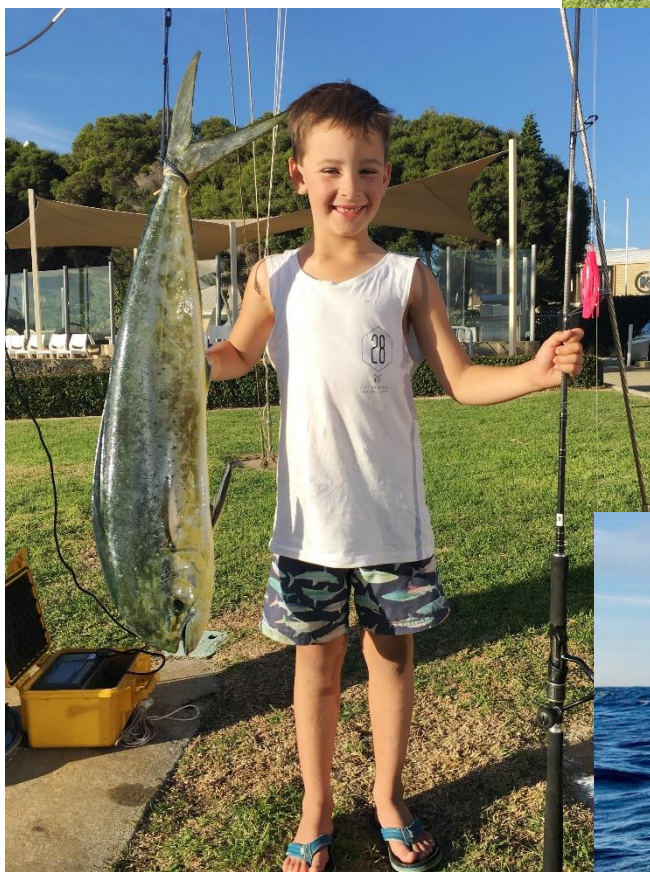

The bite was pretty quiet but they still managed to get into a few. Trying out some new Vexed jighead/ assist hooks with Zman soft plastics which worked quite well as can be seen by the photos. Because the bite was so shut down they were fishing plastics like baits and they were getting eaten!



Catches for the few days included dhufish, pink snapper, queen snapper, baldchin groper, breaksea cod, all demersals and all good eating.



FADs

The FADs are brimming with mahi mahi at the moment with fish up to 7kg around them. Live bait seems to be the most reliable but they are taking jet head lures as well. Get out to them soon because they are close to being recovered for the winter.

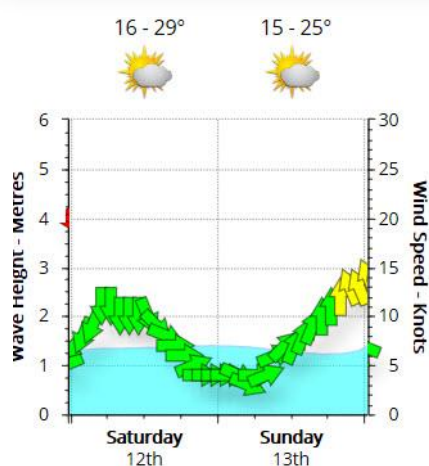
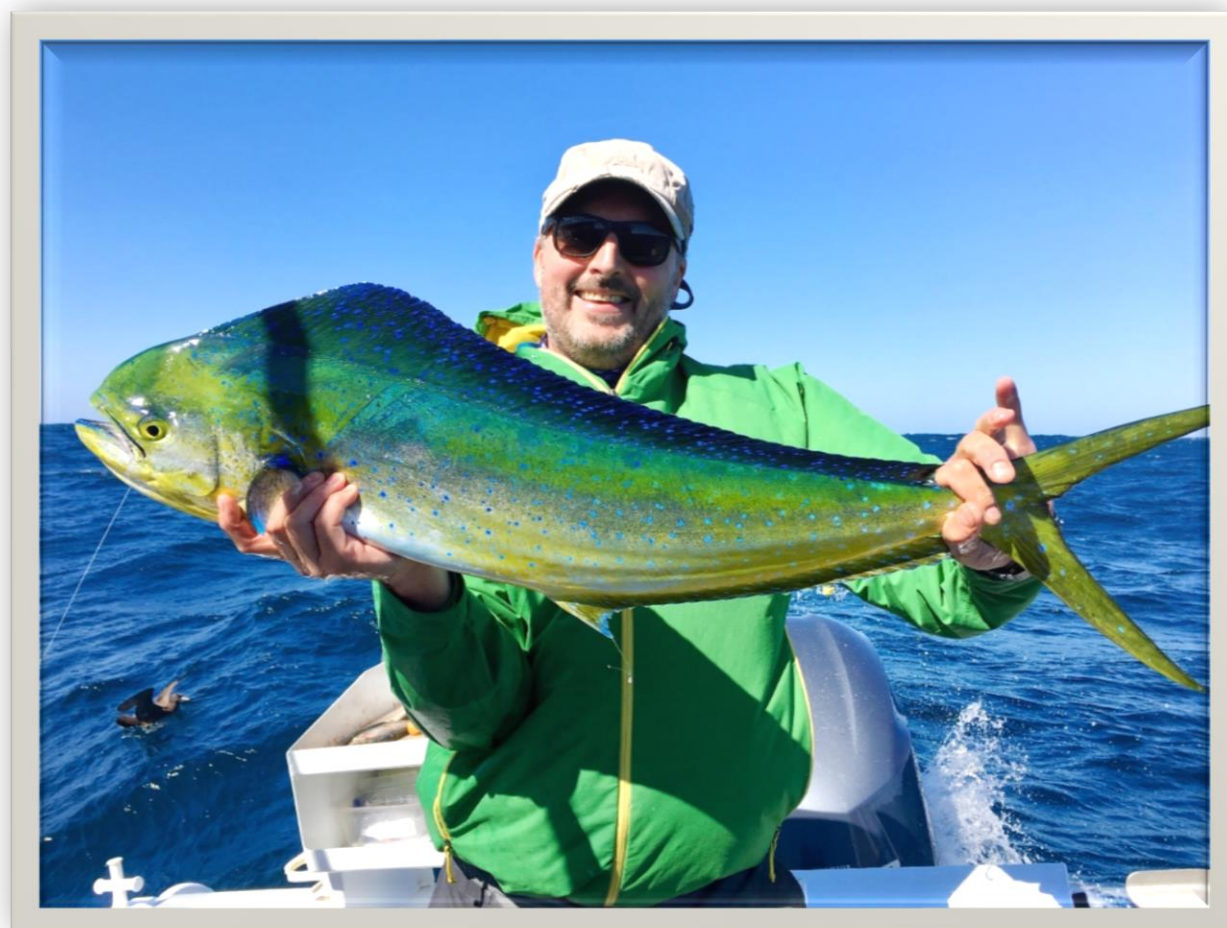
Committee Changes
